History of the Association

On Sunday July 14, 2013, Iwo Baptist High School Old Students Association, North America Chapter held its first telephone conference. This inaugural meeting of the old students came about as a result of informal discussion among the 1971-75 old students such as Mr. Olarinde Ijitimehin, Pastor Jonathan Olusanya, Dr. Tunde Adepoju, Mrs. Layonu Omotosho, and Mrs. Jokotade Ipaye. On September 29, 2013, the executive body of the chapter composed of six officers was constituted through volunteering and nomination.

The association was formally incorporated as a Nonprofit with the State of Georgia on May 13, 2014 with the expressed purpose "to create a conducive atmosphere for learning and promote the welfare and image of Baptist High School Iwo Nigeria." Efforts are also being made to register the association with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) as a 501 (c) (3) for Recognition of Exemption as a Nonprofit. A corporate account has equally been established with the Bank of America.

Today, total membership of the chapter is still modest and we implore other old students who are estimated to be over 100 in the United States and Canada to join the chapter. The executive meets every second Sunday of the month while the general members' meeting holds on the fourth Sunday of the month.
